Located just inside the Gold Gate entrance in the main court yard near the fountain and antique merry-go-round, the Pavilion is comprised of two floors, which are available as one unit or individually as desired. The second floor of the Pavilion, which overlooks the Grandstand and the ShowPlex Exhibition Center, is easily accessible with a service elevator and a glass enclosed escalator.
